



## **Guidelines for 2021 ASP Student Conference Travel Grant**

### **2021 ASP Annual Conference will be held at the Shangri-la Hotel, Cairns, QLD from Monday 5 – Thursday 8 July.**

The Australian Society for Parasitology offers all bona fide ASP student members the opportunity for part reimbursement of the costs of attending the Annual Meeting of the Society. The money available varies from year to year but usually covers between 50 and 75% of the Registration, Accommodation and Travel costs. The actual amount of reimbursement depends on the costs of the Meeting and the numbers of students applying. All student members of at least 3 months standing (i.e. applicants must have been a member of the ASP for at least 3 months prior to the commencement of the conference, in this case, prior to 06 April 2021) may apply for this bursary provided they are enrolled at a recognised Australian University. Postgraduate students are eligible for up to 1 year after completion of their studies.

To apply for a 2021 ASP Student Conference Travel Grant register for the conference <https://www.conftool.org/parasitology2021/> once registration has opened and complete all the fields in the ASP Students Conference Travel Grants section. If you have already registered for the conference please log in to conftool and under the heading “As participant you have the following options:” select “Edit Your Participant Registration Details” and complete all the fields in the ASP Students Conference Travel Grants section.

**To be eligible for a 2021 ASP Student Conference Travel Grant you must have a valid ASP Student membership by 6 April 2021 and meet all of the other criteria. Please apply online through your conference registration by the early bird deadline 5 April 2021.**

The conditions of the ASP Student Conference Travel Grant are:

1. Applicants must be currently, or recently (less than one year’s duration), enrolled for a higher degree. Applicants are eligible for up to 1 year after completion of their postgraduate studies.

2. Applicants must have been a member of the ASP for at least 3 months prior to the commencement of the conference (ie. **prior to 6 April 2021**).
3. Successful applicants should attend the 2021 ASP conference in person.
4. Successful applicants should attend the 2021 ASP AGM in person during Conference at the Adelaide Convention Centre.
5. It is not essential for current students to present a paper at the conference to be eligible for the award. However, we do strongly encourage students to present their work, even if they have obtained preliminary data.
6. Applicants are encouraged to promote the ASP during their activities; this may include using the ASP logo on presentations, and acknowledging the ASP support. Logos and wording to acknowledge the ASP support will be supplied to awardees.
7. Realistic estimates of travel and accommodation costs must be provided upon application. Applicants must list the actual or estimated cost of fees, accommodation, and travel as part of their conference registration form.
8. Administration of the ASP Student Conference Travel Grant will be the responsibility of the student's host institution. Payment will be made upon receipt of a tax invoice from the applicant's host institution. It will be the responsibility of the applicant's host institution to keep records (including all relevant receipts) of the expenses paid from the ASP grant. Alternatively students may complete an ASP requisition form and forward this along with all tax receipts directly to the ASP Treasurer for payment of the Grant.
9. Details of the awardee and their institution may be used for publicity purposes.
10. **Please ensure you are a member of the ASP by 06 April 2021.**
11. **Please apply for 2019 ASP Student Conference Travel Grant by 6 April 2021.**
